

April 2015 Labor Trends

Palm Beach County's April unemployment rate of 4.7% is down from the March rate of 5.0% reflecting a net gain of 2,027 jobs.

Continued employment growth for Palm Beach County is indicated by the **3.6** percentage increase in the number of total non-agricultural jobs during the last twelve months. This represents a net gain of 20,600 jobs.
