

June 2015 Labor Trends

Palm Beach County's June unemployment rate of 5.2% is up from the May rate of 5.1% reflecting a slight net gain of 511 jobs.

Continued employment growth for Palm Beach County is indicated by the **2.9** percentage increase in the number of total non-agricultural jobs during the last twelve months. This represents a net gain of 15,900 jobs.
