Roy C. Katzin, MD, is a board-certified neurologist who has been in practice in Boca Raton for the past 31 years. Born and raised in South Florida, he attended Rutgers University and the University of Miami Miller School of Medicine; he performed his internal medicine internship at the Medical University of South Carolina and his neurology residency at the University of Miami Hospitals and Clinics.
