

Florida's IT research and development activities are worth over \$8 billion annually. Florida ranks as the fourth state in high-tech establishments, is the third-largest exporter of high-tech products, and fifth in high-tech employment. More than 26,000 IT companies that call Florida home employ close to a quarter of a million workers.



Thanks to strong educational systems and workforce initiatives, Palm Beach County is proud of its diverse talent pipeline that provides current and future Infotech companies with the skilled workers and forward thinkers needed for a competitive advantage.

The School District of Palm Beach County is the 11th-largest in the continental U.S. and the fifth-largest in the state of Florida. It has 279 award-winning Choice Programs and Career Academies, including 11 Information Technology specialties offered in multiple locations.

A wide variety of high-tech and innovative programs and degrees are available, reflecting the growing opportunities and ever-changing needs of the Information Technology industry. Those institutions preparing students for employment in the IT industry include:

Lynn University in Boca Raton prepares students for careers in Digital Media, Design Strategies for Web Development, Computer Animation, Digital Art and Design, Graphic and Web Design, Web Design Technology, and many more concentrations in various Associate, Bachelor and Master Degrees.

Florida Atlantic University’s (FAU) College of Engineering and Computer Science offers Bachelor’s degrees in IT and Management, Computer Engineering, and Computer Science. The Master of Science in IT and Management is jointly offered with the College of Business.

Keiser University offers Bachelor of Science degrees in Cyber Forensics/ Information Security, IT Management, Management Information Systems, Network Systems and Data Communications, and Software Engineering. Keiser has two Palm Beach County campuses, including its flagship residential college.

Simultaneous M.S./Ph.D. programs are available in some disciplines.

Palm Beach Atlantic University's Bachelor's degrees in Computer Information Systems and Computer Science prepare students to work in fields such as information systems development, database administration, web development, and network systems security.

Palm Beach State College (PBSC) offers a Bachelor of Applied Science in Information Management, with concentrations in database administration, security and network assurance, and project management, and Associate in Science in Computer Programming, Internet Services Technology, Networking Administration, and Graphic Design Technology. An Advanced Technical Certificate in Computer Information Security is also available.

PBSC also offers College Credit Certification as a Cisco CCENT, CCNA Routing and Switching, or CCNA Security. Other certifications include Computer Programming Specialist, Information Management, Information Security, IT Administration, IT Technician, Java Programming, Mobile Application Development, Programming, Web Development Specialist, and Web design.

The Corporate and Continuing Education division at PBSC works with employers to offer individual and customized group training designed for their workforce needs with short-term courses, workshops, or seminars at the convenient campus locations, or on-site.

Palm Beach Code School prepares students for entry-level work as junior web developers with 16-week courses that teach front-end design, back-end programming, and database management in a hands-on setting. Faculty members are professionals with extensive industry experience.

Palm Beach Tech Association is a non-profit 501(c)6 membership association uniting the software, engineering, digital, and information technology industry verticals throughout Palm Beach County. As a countywide trade association, Palm Beach Tech is building the Palm Beaches into a Tech Hub.
