

April 2018 Labor Trends

Palm Beach County's April unemployment rate of 3.3% is down from the March rate of 3.6% reflecting a net gain of 2,749 jobs.

Continued employment growth for Palm Beach County is indicated by the **0.1** percentage increase in the number of total non-agricultural jobs during the last twelve months. This represents a net gain of 500 jobs.
