

## **June 2018 Labor Trends**

Palm Beach County's June unemployment rate of 3.9% is up from the May rate of 3.3% reflecting a net loss of 4,586 jobs.

However continued employment growth for Palm Beach County is indicated by the **0.5** percentage increase in the number of total non-agricultural jobs during the last twelve months. This represents a net gain of 3,100 jobs.
