## March 2018 Labor Trends



Palm Beach County's March unemployment rate of 3.6% is down from the February rate of 3.7% reflecting a net gain of 430 jobs.

Continued employment growth for Palm Beach County is indicated by the **1.0** percentage increase in the number of total non-agricultural jobs during the last twelve months. This represents a net gain of 6,100 jobs.
