October 2018 Labor Trends



Palm Beach County's October unemployment rate of 3.1% is steady with the September rate of 3.1% reflecting a slight net gain of 503 jobs.

Continued employment growth for Palm Beach County is indicated by the **2.6** percentage increase in the number of total non-agricultural jobs during the last twelve months. This represents a net gain of 16,100 jobs.
