

## **April 2019 Labor Trends**

Palm Beach County's April unemployment rate of 2.9% is down from the March rate of 3.2% reflecting a net gain of 2,787 jobs.

Continued employment growth for Palm Beach County is indicated by the **2.8** percentage increase in the number of total non-agricultural jobs during the last twelve months. This represents a net gain of 17,600 jobs.
