

June 2020 Labor Trends

Palm Beach County's June unemployment rate of 10.4% is down from the May rate of 14.1% reflecting a net gain of 19,396 jobs.

An overall reduction in employment for Palm Beach County is indicated by the **-8.7** percentage decrease in the number of total non-agricultural jobs during the last twelve months. This represents a net loss of 54,900 jobs.
