

## March 2020 Labor Trends

Palm Beach County's March unemployment rate of 4.4% is up from the February rate of 3.1% reflecting a net loss of 9,392 jobs.

However continued employment growth for Palm Beach County is indicated by the **0.2** percentage increase in the number of total non-agricultural jobs during the last twelve months. This represents a net gain of 1,600 jobs.
