

May 2012 Labor Trends

Palm Beach County's May unemployment rate of 8.6% is up from the April rate of 8.5% reflecting a net loss of 1,594 jobs.

However, an employment growth for Palm Beach County is indicated by the **0.4** percentage increase in the number of total non-agricultural jobs during the last twelve months. This represents a net gain of 1,800 jobs.
