

## **August 2012 Labor Trends**

Palm Beach County's August unemployment rate of 9.6% is down from the July rate of 9.8% reflecting a net gain of 2,234 jobs.

However, a reduction in employment for Palm Beach County is indicated by the -0.5 percentage decrease in the number of total non-agricultural jobs during the last twelve months. This represents a net loss of 2,600 jobs.
