

September 2012 Labor Trends

Palm Beach County's September unemployment rate of 9.2% is down from the August rate of 9.6% reflecting a net gain of 1,798 jobs.

However, a reduction in employment for Palm Beach County is indicated by the -0.2 percentage decrease in the number of total non-agricultural jobs during the last twelve months. This represents a net loss of 800 jobs.
