

## **August 2013 Labor Trends**

Palm Beach County's August unemployment rate of 7.5% is down from the July rate of 7.7% reflecting a gain of 1,861 jobs.

Continued employment growth for Palm Beach County is indicated by the **1.9** percentage increase in the number of total non-agricultural jobs during the last twelve months. This represents a net gain of 9,500 jobs.
