October 2013 Labor Trends



Palm Beach County's October unemployment rate of 6.7% is down from the September rate of 7.1% reflecting a gain of 3,325 jobs.

Continued employment growth for Palm Beach County is indicated by the **2.4** percentage increase in the number of total non-agricultural jobs during the last twelve months. This represents a net gain of 12,600 jobs.
