

April 2014 Labor Trends

Palm Beach County's April unemployment rate of 5.6% is down from the March rate of 6.3% reflecting a net gain of 4,957 jobs.

Continued employment growth for Palm Beach County is indicated by the **2.8** percentage increase in the number of total non-agricultural jobs during the last twelve months. This represents a net gain of 15,300 jobs.
