

## **August 2014 Labor Trends**

Palm Beach County's August unemployment rate of 6.6% is steady with the July rate of 6.6% reflecting a slight net loss of 183 jobs.

Continued employment growth for Palm Beach County is indicated by the 2.7 percentage increase in the number of total non-agricultural jobs during the last twelve months. This represents a net gain of 14,600 jobs.
