## **November 2014 Labor Trends**



Palm Beach County's November unemployment rate of 5.2% is down from the October rate of 5.6% reflecting a net gain of 2,414 jobs.

Continued employment growth for Palm Beach County is indicated by the **2.3** percentage increase in the number of total non-agricultural jobs during the last twelve months. This represents a net gain of 12,900 jobs.
