

August 2015 Labor Trends

Palm Beach County's August unemployment rate of 5.5% is down from the July rate of 5.6% reflecting a net gain of 1,001 jobs.

Continued employment growth for Palm Beach County is indicated by the **2.5** percentage increase in the number of total non-agricultural jobs during the last twelve months. This represents a net gain of 14,200 jobs.
