January 2016 Labor Trends



Palm Beach County's January unemployment rate of 4.9% is up from the December rate of 4.5% reflecting a net loss of 2,623 jobs.

However, continued employment growth for Palm Beach County is indicated by the **3.4** percentage increase in the number of total non-agricultural jobs during the last twelve months. This represents a net gain of 19,700 jobs.
