

July 2016 Labor Trends

Palm Beach County's July unemployment rate of 5.2% is up from the June rate of 4.9% reflecting a net loss of 43 jobs and an 8,383 growth in labor force.

However, continued employment growth for Palm Beach County is indicated by the **3.1** percentage increase in the number of total non-agricultural jobs during the last twelve months. This represents a net gain of 18,000 jobs.
