

March 2016 Labor Trends

Palm Beach County's March unemployment rate of 4.5% is steady with the February rate of 4.5% reflecting a slight net gain of 394 jobs.

Continued employment growth for Palm Beach County is indicated by the **2.4** percentage increase in the number of total non-agricultural jobs during the last twelve months. This represents a net gain of 14,100 jobs.
