

## **November 2016 Labor Trends**

Palm Beach County's November unemployment rate of **4.9%** is down from the October rate of 5.1% reflecting a net gain of 586 jobs.

Continued employment growth for Palm Beach County is indicated by the **2.2** percentage increase in the number of total non-agricultural jobs during the last twelve months. This represents a net gain of 13,200 jobs.
