The total population of Palm Beach County grew by 31.0 percent (267,666) people from 1990 to 2000. This is both a smaller number and a much slower rate of growth than that experienced in the 1980s when the county grew by 49.8 percent and 286,760 people. Palm Beach County however, remained the fastest growing large county in South Florida. The only counties growing at a faster rate are those that had a much smaller base population in 1990 such as Collier, Glades, and Hendry counties. The University of Florida's Bureau of Business and Economic Research estimates that Palm Beach County's population has grown by an additional 80,257 individuals between 2000 and 2003. Population in Palm Beach County is estimated to have reached 1,211,448 an increase of 7.1 percent from the 2000 level of 1,131,191.
